

Admissions to Primary Schools in September 2016 Parents' Information Leaflet



Dear Parent/Carer

You have been given this leaflet because you live in Walsall and your child is eligible to enter a Reception class (children born between 01.09.11 and 31.08.12) or transfer to a Junior school in September 2016 (children born between 01.09.08 and 31.08.09). If you don't live in Walsall you should contact the Local Authority (LA) in which you live for details of how to apply for a school place (contact details for other authorities are on page three of this document).

In this leaflet you will find details of how to apply even though the school may be in another Local Authority. You will also find details of how to apply online and how you will find out the result of your application.

You can get further, more detailed, information from our website (www.walsall.gov.uk/education) where you can view a copy of our full 'Information for Parents' booklet. **You should read the 'Information for Parents' booklet before submitting your application.**

If you need help to make your online application, telephone our Parent Support Adviser on 01922 652578 or a member of the Admissions and Pupil Place Planning Team on 01922 652585.

With this leaflet you will find a Supplementary Information Form (SIF). The SIF must be completed if you are applying for any of the Voluntary Aided Catholic or Church of England primary schools or Voluntary Controlled Church of England primary schools. The SIF is not an application for a school place and you must also submit an online application.

You can make your application online either from home or any public library, all you need is an email address. If you are unsure about how to use the internet, our Parent Support Adviser or staff in libraries will be pleased to help you. To make an application online please follow the instructions at www.walsall.gov.uk/education.

The closing date for applications is 15 January 2016.

When you apply online you will receive the result of your application by email on 18 April 2016. To find out details of individual Walsall schools look at the online version of the 'Information for Parents booklet'.

Please follow the online instructions carefully. If you are unable to complete the form on your first visit you may finish it later by logging on to the website and continuing with the application. Be sure that you have completed your form properly before you submit it.

You can apply for any school online, but if you wish to be considered for a place at a Voluntary Controlled or Voluntary Aided primary school you will also have to complete a Supplementary Information Form (SIF). This form is included in this pack and is available on the Walsall Council website.

Schools in other boroughs may require additional forms, so you will need to contact the relevant school or LA.

When children can start school – 'Rising Five' Admission

Children must, by law, start school at the beginning of the term after their fifth birthday. However, children can start school in the September of the school year in which they have their fifth birthday. You may delay your child's entry to school (deferred entry), but all children must start school by the term after their fifth birthday.

If you want to delay your child's entry to school to after their fifth birthday then you must request this in writing and still complete an online form.

Please note that having a place in the nursery class attached to a school does not guarantee a place in the reception class at that school. You must apply separately for a place in the Reception Class.

The Application Process

You can apply for up to three primary/infant schools for Reception, or three junior schools for Year 3. Please ensure that you make only ONE online application. **The schools do not have to be Walsall schools. You can apply for schools in other local authorities.**

For some schools outside Walsall you may need to fill in extra forms. To find out whether this applies to your preferences, please contact the school direct or speak to the admissions team in the relevant local authority.

You are strongly advised to contact the appropriate local authority if you are applying on medical, social or denominational grounds for schools outside Walsall as you may need to complete supplementary forms or provide additional information.

All schools have 'oversubscription criteria'. These are rules which help us to decide which children should be offered places in the event of our receiving more applications than there are places available. Criteria for all Walsall schools are included in the 'Information for Parents' booklet, which is available online. **If you are applying for a school outside of Walsall you should contact the relevant local authority to obtain details of the admission criteria for the school.**

It is very important that you complete your online application form fully and accurately. Please ensure that all relevant parts of the application are completed and submit your application by the closing date of 15 January 2016. Your child's chances of being offered one of your preferred schools may be significantly reduced if you do not submit your application on time.

Pupil details

- 1 Please give full details of the child for whom you are requesting a school place. Ensure that you complete each part of the application. If you have any questions please contact the Parent Support Adviser or the Admissions and Pupil Place Planning Team who will be happy to help you.
- 2 If your child has a statement of special educational needs or an Education, Health & Care Plan, it is important that you complete this section of the application as the Admissions and Pupil Place Planning Team will forward your application to the SEN Team for processing, as your child has priority for admission.
- 3 If your child is in public care (ie in the care of the Local Authority) or was previously looked after, your child will be given priority for admission to primary school, so please fill in these details carefully.

School Preferences

- 4 Please list all the schools you wish your child to be considered for in the order you would like us to consider them. Please note that each school must only be entered once. If you express a preference for only one school, or repeat the name of the school in more than one box, this will not increase your chances of being offered this school. If you have an older child/children (sibling connection) at the school you are applying for you must list them in this section. The sibling connection is only considered if the older child will still be at the school when the younger child starts and must be living at the same address as the younger child. If your child is at an infant school and has an older sibling who attends a paired junior school you must tick the box on the application to indicate that there is a sibling connection and the provide details of the older sibling.
- 5 If you would like your child to be considered for a place at any school on medical or social grounds, you must tick the box in this section and complete the other reasons box that appears. You will need to provide a letter from a medical or social work professional, stating that this is the only school that can meet the child's needs and giving reasons why. Any application made on these grounds will need to be verified by the Executive Director of Children's Services.
- 6 Please ensure that the application is completed by a person who has parental responsibility for the child named in the application, as failure to do so could delay the processing of your application. In accepting the terms and conditions you are stating that you understand that a place may be withdrawn if it is offered because of fraudulent or misleading information and that you will notify the Admissions and Pupil Place Planning Team if you change address during the process, or if an older sibling is admitted to the school after you have submitted your application.

There is space in the application to include your reasons for applying but please note that any information that you include in this section will only be taken into account if it relates to the admission criteria for your preferred schools.
